Michael Lewis plans to resign as CEO of E.ON UK to become new CEO of Uniper

Düsseldorf-based energy group Uniper announced today that the company's supervisory board intends to appoint Michael Lewis, currently CEO of E.ON UK, as its new CEO.

E.ON CEO Leonhard Birnbaum: "We are delighted for Michael that he has been offered this high-profile role in the German energy industry and we know that Uniper has made an excellent choice in him. At the same time, we regret that Michael plans to leave E.ON. We are currently in constructive discussions with Uniper to reach an agreement on a suitable transition date." In parallel, the selection process for a successor to Michael Lewis has begun. Until the transition is ensured, Michael Lewis will continue to lead the business of E.ON UK unchanged.
