Data protection information

1. Voluntary nature of consent
 - a) Any personal data is provided on a voluntary basis. I am under no legal or contractual obligation to provide my data.

2. Right to withdraw consent
I have the right to withdraw my consent to future processing at any time. This will not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.
3. Further processing
