

This is how 175 years of Glashütte watchmaking tradition gives rise to timepieces which are unsurpassed throughout the world. A range of diameters ensures each wrist will find the right watch.

To this day, their designs are based on the rules of Bauhaus and Deutscher Werkbund—albeit taking liberties with case and dial shades, as well as strap materials. A huge success: NOMOS watches have garnered 170 international awards in the categories for design and quality since the fall of the Berlin Wall. Most of the models have long since become classics, and others with improved designs are likely to become the classics of tomorrow. Here are the manufacture's favorites for the Fall/Winter of 22/23: Watches which are particularly worthwhile as investments, models of timeless beauty—and most of all, those which have just debuted on the market.

Duo is the name of NOMOS Glashütte's elegant two-handed models with a small diameter or edge length: This square Tetra 27 Duo is the perfect hand-wound watch for everyone who prefers modest sizes. Highly precise, even without the seconds hand: NOMOS caliber Alpha keeps the time.
