This is how 175 years of Glashütte watchmaking tradition gives rise to timepieces which are unsurpassed throughout the world.

These are enduring, beautiful instruments which accentuate our personality—watches give us character. NOMOS watches have garnered 170 international awards in the categories for design and quality since the fall of the Berlin Wall. Most of the models have long since become classics, and others with improved designs are likely to become the classics of tomorrow. Here are the manufacturer's favorites for the Fall/Winter of 22/23: Watches which are particularly worthwhile as investments, models of timeless beauty—and of course those which have just debuted on the market.

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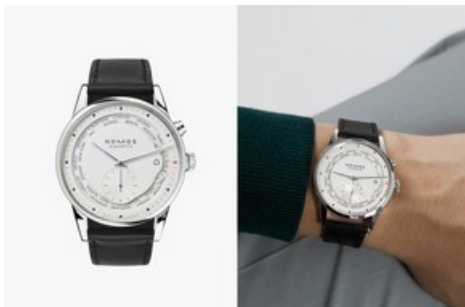
Ahoi Atlantic. Shown left without, and right with date. Both versions represent the ideal watch—for sports, business or dates. The fabulous “NOMOS allrounder” benefits from its robust crown guard, numbers and hands which are easy to read in the dark, and of course its super slim and powerful hand-made caliber.



The generously sized NOMOS classic with a new, patented addition: A date ring lines the circumference of the dial of this Tangente neomatik 41 Update. Two red dots frame the current day. The flat neomatik caliber DUW 6101 keeps the watch slender despite its automatic winder.



Club Sport neomatik 42 date blue: The new, highly precise automatic watch from the Club Sport series features a striking blue dial. The model is fitted with the handmade NOMOS neomatik caliber DUW 6101 and a stainless steel bracelet. This robust timepiece has a compact case height of just 10.2 millimeters.



Zürich world time: 24 watches in one. Travel the world with the push of a button, and have this watch show the time for Sydney, Denver, Alaska, New York... Complications made uncomplicated, and equally useful for those who like to stay in, peruse the internet, or phone friends in Honolulu. An undeniably masculine watch, with fine lines that embody the very essence of what the British like to call sophistication.



The definition of magnificence: Lambda rose gold. Encased in fine gold, the watch has been designed according to the rules of science, and crafted with patience and skill according to the rules of Glashütte fine watchmaking. A timepiece to evoke the strongest feelings. The haute horlogerie caliber features, among other things, a twin mainspring barrel and power reserve indicator. Once fully wound, this watch will run for half a week, or 84 hours.



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
